## **II. Important Notices**

### **(1) Requirement of Membership of EASTS for Presentation**

Those who want to present a paper at the Conference should have an "EASTS Regular Member ID". Any paper that is not presented at the Conference will not be included in the Proceedings and Journals, either. Unless you have a Regular Member ID, you are required to apply for a membership to one of the domestic societies of EASTS, to which you (will) belong by the end of February in 2011. Those who have no access to any of the EASTS member societies are requested to follow the procedure shown in the following URL. ### **(2) Financial Support**

EASTS provides financial support (conference registration, lowest airfare and accommodation fees) only for the **EASTS regular members**, who will present a paper with the excellent review results and belong to the following EASTS member countries/regions/societies: Cambodia, China, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, and Mongolia.

### **(3) Publication of Asian Transport Studies (ATS) Journal**

"Asian Transport Studies (ATS)" is published in addition to the existing EASTS Journal. It aims at providing useful insights into solving Asia-specific transport-related issues from both theoretical and practical perspectives. It treats all types of transport modes and all issues in transport sector. Even though papers dealing with the Asia-specific issues are especially welcome, other papers related to transportation studies are also within the scope of this journal. ATS Journal was established in 2009 and is published biannually. Selected papers will be published in one of four issues over two years (Selection method refers to the following Paper Selection). Authors of selected papers will be informed of the acceptance of their papers for publication in advance. Before publication, English editing services will be provided to each paper for free. Papers included in the first volume of ATS were selected from the 8th EASTS Conference held in Surabaya, Indonesia, on November 16-19, 2009. Rate of acceptance was about 5%. EASTS is trying to promote the ATS journal as an internationally well-cited journal in near future. Details of ATS and the selected papers for the first volume can be found at the following URL.

### **(4) Paper Selection**

#### *(4-1) Academic Papers*

(Selection order: EASTS Proceedings → EASTS Journal → ATS Journal → EASTS Paper Awards)  
Academic papers submitted to EASTS Conference will be peer-reviewed and selected into EASTS Proceedings, EASTS Journal, or Asian Transport Studies (ATS) Journal, where ATS Journal especially collects outstanding papers dealing with Asia-specific issues. Best papers will be awarded "EASTS Best Paper Awards".

#### *(4-2) Practical Papers*

(Selection order: EASTS Proceedings → ATS Journal → EASTS Paper Awards)  
Practical papers submitted to EASTS Conference will be peer-reviewed and selected into EASTS Proceedings or Asian Transport Studies (ATS) Journal, where ATS Journal especially collects outstanding papers that deal with Asia-specific issues. Best papers will be awarded "EASTS Best Paper Awards".

#### *(4-3) ATS Journal and EASTS Paper Awards*

(Paper Awards: Best Paper Awards and YASOSHIMA Yoshinosuke Prize)

Papers for ATS Journal and EASTS Best Paper Awards will be selected from both academic and practical papers that are evaluated to contribute excellently in one or more of the following areas, in addition to standard paper review criteria.

- (a) Enlightening Asia-specific topics
- (b) Discovering interesting facts
- (c) Technological innovation
- (d) Institutional innovation

- (e) Theoretical development
- (f) Methodological development
- (g) Best application in practices
- (h) Difficult research accumulations

EASTS Best Paper Awards will be given to a maximum of 10 selected academic and/or practical papers during the EASTS Conference. YASOSHIMA Yoshinosuke Prize can be given to the most excellent paper, if any, among the above-selected best papers.

EASTS Paper Awards will be finally determined during the EASTS Conference. Papers for ATS Journal will be finally determined after EASTS Conference and EASTS Awards Papers will be automatically included in ATS Journal.

NOTE: Selected papers for EASTS Proceedings, EASTS Journal, EASTS Paper Awards, and ATS Journal must be presented in the EASTS Conference.

### **III. Tips from International Scientific Committee (ISC)**

#### **(1) Encouragement to Submit Practical Papers**

We strongly recommend the participation of professionals from governments and transportation-related businesses. For this purpose, we have set up a 'Practical Paper' category since the Conference in 2007. Practical papers will be selected from those covering timely and useful topics such as on-going transportation projects, recent issues or practical suggestions on transportation policies in the Asia region. Different from academic papers, the review process is simpler and, usefulness, timeliness, reliability, and practical novelty will be highly evaluated.

#### **(2) Prospect of Transportation Study**

ISC provides the Research Vision Report which describes the areas and views of the research directions in the Asian region. It covers not only general topics but also regional topics such as history and culture. Those who are willing to join the Conference and to submit a paper are recommended to read it in advance.
